

Driving from Victoria:

Coming off the ferry, go straight onto Ferry Terminal Rd - 72 feet.

Turn right to stay on Ferry Terminal Rd - 456 feet.

Turn left at Oswego St - 131 feet.

Turn left at Belleville St - 0.4 miles.

Turn left at Douglas St - 2.5 miles.

Continue on HWY-1 N - about 10.6 miles.

Turn right to stay on HWY-1 N - about 52.7 miles.

Take the ramp onto Nanaimo Pkwy and travel north on Highway 19 - about 26 miles.

Take Exit 60 onto Highway 4 (also known as the Pacific Rim Highway) heading west for 156 km (97 miles). You will drive through spectacular Cathedral Grove, historic Port Alberni (drive straight downhill and turn right at the junction), and on the winding road around Sproat and Kennedy Lakes. You will also drive through scenic Sutton Pass, at an altitude of 250m (850 feet) - where we especially recommend heeding to the speed limit. Travel westward until you come to the junction between Tofino and Ucluelet.

Turn left at the Tofino/Ucluelet junction and drive south towards Ucluelet (Peninsula Road).

On Peninsula Road keep straight until you just pass the Canadian Princess Resort and then turn Left onto Hemlock Street. Follow Hemlock for about 500 yards until you reach the public parking lot on your left. Parking is available in this lot or on the streets. An Eagle Nook Staff member will meet you at the dock.

Your overall travel time from Victoria to the Ucluelet Boat Basin Marina will range between 3.5 and 4 hours - we wish you safe travels!
