Fishing in 2011:

Eagle Nook has been offering guided fishing for as long as its existence. This year we have exciting news as continue to do things differently. Eagle Nook Resort & Spa and Lucky Sports Fishing are continuing to work together to serve you better. We are very pleased with this development and feel confident that you will benefit from this as well.

Pre Season forecasts for the summer of 2011 are very encouraging with predictions that the fishing in June, July and early August on the West Coast and areas of Barkley Sound will be even better than in 2010. Oregon fish and wildlife has announced that the early spring run of Chinook set to return to the Columbia River and its immediate tributaries could be as high as 470,000. This means that these fish will begin to appear around Barkley Sound and the Ucluelet area in May and should peak sometime in June. Most of these fish swim relatively close to the nutrient rich waters of Vancouver Island's outer coastline and feed hard for long periods of the day as they near the end of their life cycle. By mid-June the mid-summer migratory flow of Chinook and the first Coho begin to

show and also feed on herring, needlefish, squid, and pacific sardines. Chinook pre season forecast returns according to a Seattle Times report are close to 700,000 fish. These salmon will peak sometime from mid-July into early August. Anglers fishing for the earlier fish should have plenty of anchovy and various Rhys colors of Rhys Davis anchovy Teaser Heads. Needlefish hootchies and needlefish style spoons are also a must.
